PE + Wellbeing Kit Expectations

Information Letter

Our PE + Wellbeing department aim to:

Inspire and develop lifelong learners that lead happy and healthy lifestyles.

In order for pupils to maintain the high standards that we have within the PE department it is essential that your child has their full and correct PE kit for all of their PE + Wellbeing lessons.

- Pupils in key stage three will have two PE / Wellbeing lessons every week.
- Pupils in key stage four will have one PE / Wellbeing lesson every week.

If a pupil fails to bring their full and correct PE kit, they will be issued a same day detention in line with our academy behaviour policy. Pupils will also receive a phone call home from a member of the PE + Wellbeing department to discuss how we can support your child moving forward.

Key points to note regarding expectations in PE:

- · No jewellery to be worn within lessons. Plasters cannot be used to cover piercings.
- · Long hair must be tied up away from the face.
- · No false nails allowed this is a health and safety issue.
- · No chewing gum.
- · None marking sole trainers.
- · If your child cannot practically take part in the lesson, they must have a note from a parent / carer / medical professional and still bring their full and correct PE kit. Your child will be given an alternative role as a coach / umpire / official / leader so that they are still able to take part and make progress.
