What is Oak National Academy?

Oak National Academy a platform that provides free teaching resources.

The curriculum covers a broad range of subjects across all year groups with lessons designed to complement those like ours who follow the National Curriculum. There are no sign-ups or logins required.

Lessons include a pre-recorded video, quizzes and worksheets.

Do I need to supervise my children while they use Oak's resources?

Each lesson has a pre-recorded video with a teacher who takes students through each section step-by-step. Each lesson can be paused and rewound to help students learn at their own pace. The level of supervision needed has been designed to be minimal.

What does my child need to take part in the lessons?

Each lesson is very clear about what you need at the start. For most there are minimal additional materials required, usually just a pen and some paper.




1. Click the 'classroom' link

Browse the classroom






3. Find the appropriate year group
